New trail friendly to visitors with disability and limited mobility at the National Park of Rila, Bulgaria

The Rila National Park Directorate has completed and made available to the public a new eco-trail, the PARANGALITSA NATURAL RESERVE TRAIL, which was designed to be visited by people with disabilities. The trail is on the E4 Trail, just 30 km from the town of Blagoevgrad and is suitable for observing the flora and fauna of the park.
