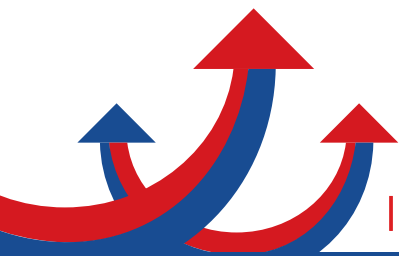

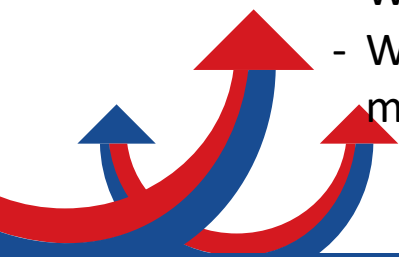

➤ NEED OF NEW SPACES FOR HISTORY MUSEUM'S EXPOSITIONS

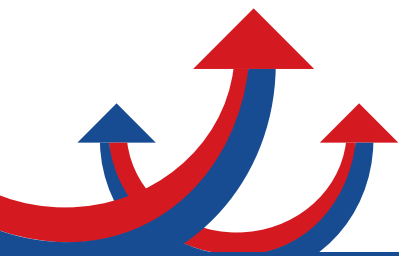


- Part of the Cultural House in Petrich

- Without suitable area around the museum



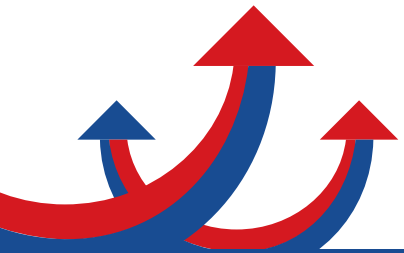
➤ NEED OF NEW SPACES FOR HISTORY MUSEUM'S EXPOSITIONS

- Lack of accessible environment for disadvantaged people

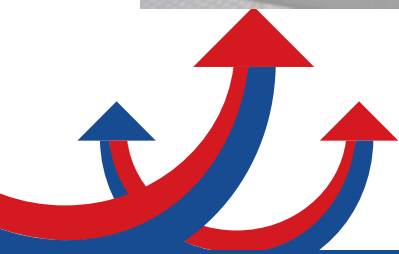

- The restoration will follow **low energy consumption** and **accessibility** principles.



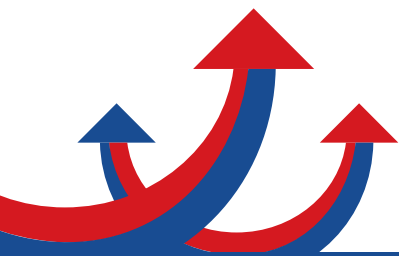
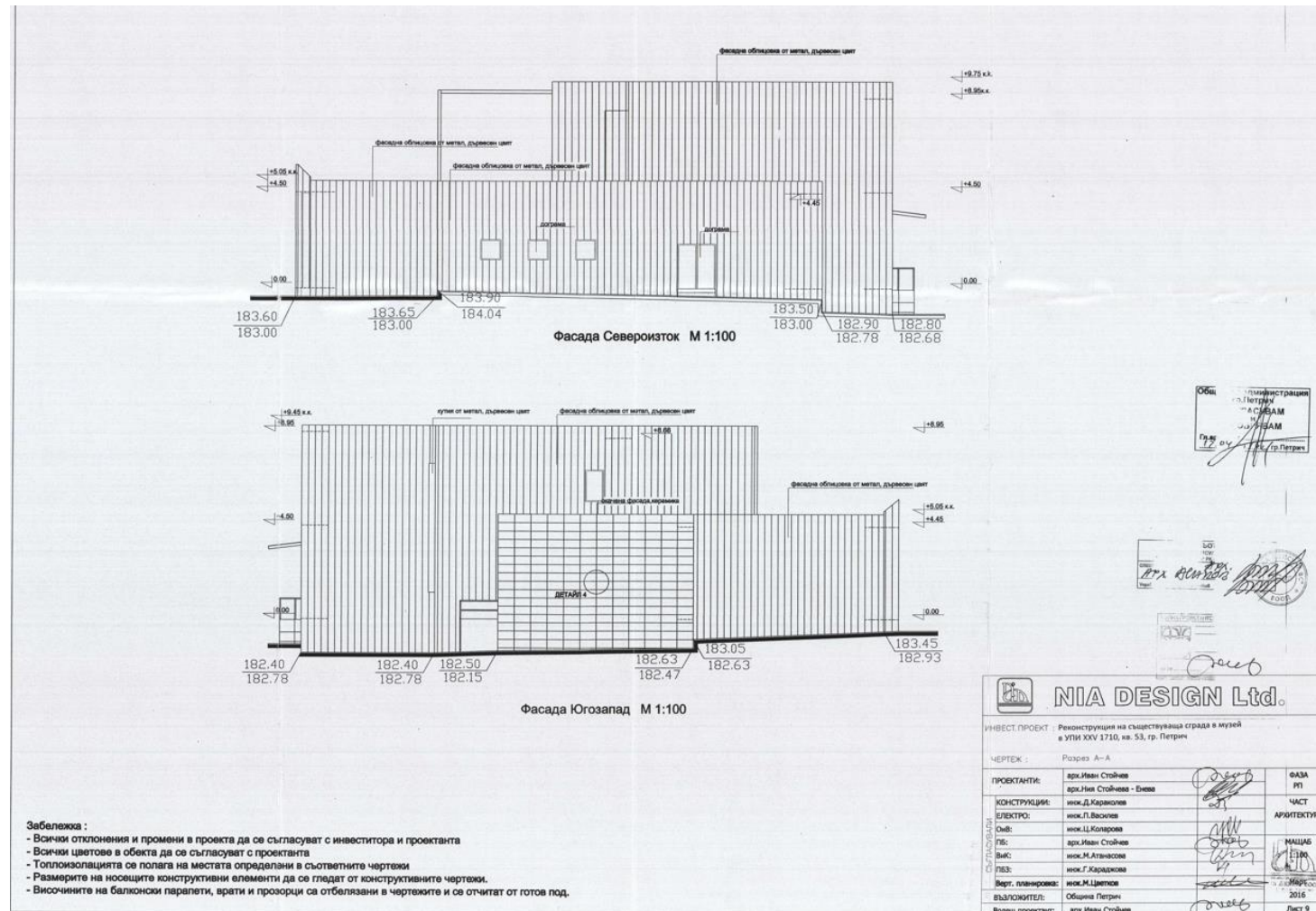

With our letter with ref. numb. 94-00-1825/13.04.2018r., delivered to the Managing Authority/Joint Secretariat, Cooperation Programme Interreg V-A “Greece-Bulgaria 2014-2020”, on 17.04.2018 we informed you that it is imperative that the Municipality of Petrich develop and submit for agreement a new investment project for reconstruction of an existing museum building due to objective circumstances which occurred, beyond the investor’s control and related to changes in the rules of construction, namely:

At the beginning of 2017 the Municipality of Petrich initiated a procedure in line with the national policy of the State through the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works for elaboration and approval of a Master plan for the territory of the Municipality of Petrich. As a result of the municipal procurement conducted procedure, a contractor was selected and with a contract dated 12.09.2017, Petrich Municipality assigned the elaboration

Dear Mr. Paskalev,

The Monitoring Committee has approved “the change in the technical design of the infrastructure part (museum), without altering the approved amount by the Programme for the infrastructure, in order to comply with the requirements of the new master plan. Any additional required funds for the infrastructure will be provided by the beneficiary itself. Furthermore, due to damages by the winter weather, the old equipment of the hall cannot be used and a new exhibition design with equipment and furniture will be developed and incorporated in the tender. The amounts for the procurement of the equipment are going to be covered by the Municipality’s own funds”. Therefore, you may proceed accordingly.

Regarding your email of 25/6 on the approval of the substitution tables, I will be providing you a written reply next week.
