







## **EUROPEAN COOPERATION DAY 2021**

## **Rooting for a greener future!**

Bright and early on **Saturday, the 25th of September**, citizens gathered at the heart of **Oreokastro**, a suburb northwest of Thessaloniki, to celebrate **European Cooperation Day**.

**European Cooperation Day**, also known as **"EC-Day**", is an initiative of the Interreg Programmes (Interact) that has been celebrated since 2011. Every year, on the 21st of September or around this date, various local events are held all over Europe to remind citizens that many good things come out when we join forces.

This year, for the **10th anniversary of the EC Day campaign**, the Managing Authority and the Joint Secretariat of the European Territorial **Cooperation Programme Interreg V-A "Greece-Bulgaria 2014-2020"** worked together with the **Municipality of Oreokastro** to organize a **tree-planting event** to not only mark the day, but also to pave the way for a greener future in the cross-border area.

On the day, the organizing team was pleased to be joined by the "Union of Pontians and Friends of Oreokastro", the "Environmental and Cultural Association of Oreokastro", and residents. Several passersby also stopped in their tracks to join in on the action. Thanks to the active participation of over 60 citizens, including children, 116 trees were planted in the area of "Alonia". Trees planted included apple, pomegranate, fig, walnut, oak, plum and hibiscus.







Home to only the Municipal Citizen's Service Centre, locals currently use this relatively empty space to walk their dogs and/or as a running track of sorts. The addition of trees will not only provide shade and color but is also the first step towards transforming this once blank terrain into a vibrant public space for the enjoyment of Oreokastro's population.
